King David had been a shepherd as a boy so the image of the Shepherd Messiah underlies today's Gospel text. But the intimacy of Jesus' relationship with his flock goes beyond even this. This gospel is a statement of the of seriousness lesus' commitment to the Father's will his and self-giving love for humankind. Jesus' life is freely given for his flock. It is sometimes thought that Jesus died to satisfy the will of the Father imposed on the Son.

This is not so. Jesus' gift was a free gift because he responded at all times to that which was most profound in him: the Father's love which he wished to make known to the world. It is generous, self-giving love for others. In what ways are we as Christians called to offer this self-giving love same for others? Who are those in our world and community who are most in need of this generous love?
