16th Sunday in Ordinary Time Saturday 16 & 17 July

This weekend the Gospel takes us to the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus, where Jesus is a guest.

Martha, Martha, you worry about "the ten thousand things." Jesus affirms: "Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her". (Luke 10: 39). "Only one thing is 10.30am @ MPH necessary," Jesus says.


Mary's sitting at Jesus' feet and listening to His Word implies July 23-NO VIGIL a communion or fellowship of her spirit with that of the MASS AT ALL Lord. Like the two men on the Emmaus Road (Luke 24:32), Mary's heart must have burned within her as she listened to July 24—Sunday Mass: Jesus explaining the Scriptures. Through her time 9am @ St Ignatius communing with the Lord at His feet, Mary developed a 10.30am @ MPH sensitivity that enabled her to anoint Him for His burial, an 5pm Youth Mass @ St action that Jesus said would be remembered wherever the Ignatius gospel is preached in the whole world (Matt. 26:13). We need to remember that the point of spending time in the Word and in prayer is not so that we can check it off on our Goals Chart. The point is to meet with the Lord, to commune with Him as Mary did, as we sit at His feet, listening to His word.
