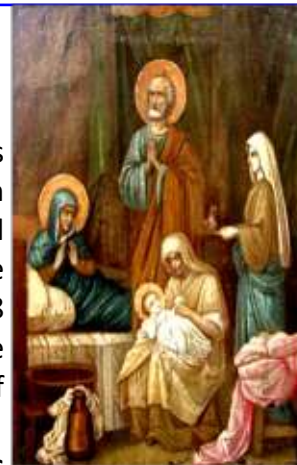

THE NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY September 8
