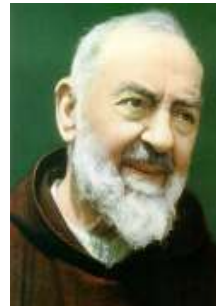

### FEAST DAY OF SAINT PADRE PIO OF PIETRECILNA

**SEPTEMBER 23**

Padre Pio got the whole world's attention through his charisma and his spiritual gifts: the stigmata, the enchanting scent he gave off, the prophecies, the gift of knowing hearts, and converting of people through his prayers. Saint Pio lived entire religious life in obedience, prayer and humility. Life in the convent for Padre Pio was a long, painful ordeal that he underwent as he participated in Christ's suffering for the salvation of souls: *"Jesus, my heart's desire and my life, today as I raise you up in trembling hands, in a mystery of love, may I be, with you, for the world, Way, Truth and Life, and for you a holy priest, a perfect victim."* He was canonized in 2002 by Pope John Paul II.

## 2022 MPH Parish Baptismal Programme

## PAYWAVE DONATION OPTION

Through a parishioner's kind donation, we have been able to fund a PayWave device, which gives parishioners another option for donating to the Church. The device accepts any card (debit or credit) provided it has the PayWave facility. You place your card against the screen, and \$10 will be automatically deducted from your account and paid to our bank account. The device is in the Foyer, next to the office. It does not issue receipts, and our bank account does not register who made the donation. Parishioners may care to use this new form of donating as opposed to putting cash in the basket at Mass or as a way of providing the Parish with additional funds. When donating leave your card against the screen momentarily, and after removal you will see a message on the screen thanking you for your donation. To donate more than \$10 give the screen time to clear before repeating the operation.
