Feast Day of St. Thérèse of Lisieux October 1st

St Therese of Lisieux was a French nun who died at the age of 24 of tuberculosis. She grew up in a very devout family, experienced the "Virgin of the Smile" during an illness, was converted at the age of 14, took a pilgrimage to Rome, and then entered the monastery in Lisieux, Carmel. She was known for her devotion to God, her plays and poems, and her battle with tuberculosis. As a teacher of the "Little Way", she was a pioneer of everyday spirituality as a path of faith in action. She was recently made a **Doctor of the Church**.
